


Take a Life (The Debt 6) by Phillip Gwynne


Finding Freia Lockhart by Aimee Said


How to Convince a Boy to Kiss You by Tara Eglinton


The Last Shot (book 2) by Michael Adams


Dead and Buried by Anne Cassidy


Lone Survivor by Marcus Luttrell with Patrick Robinson


The End of the World as We Know It by Iva- Marie Palmer
