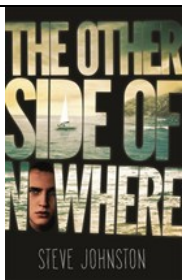
The Death Cure by James Dashner

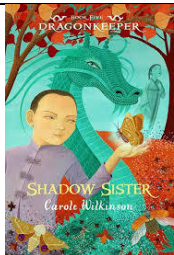
Where the Rock Splits the Sky by Philip Web

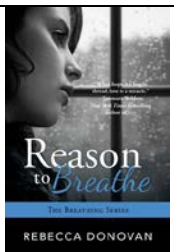
The Other Side of Nowhere by Steve Johnson

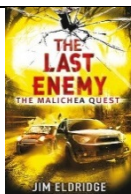
Reason to Breathe (Book 1) by Rebecca Donovan

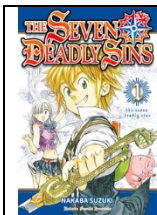
Throne of Glass by Sarah J. Maas

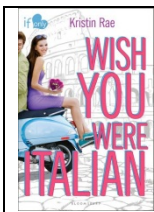
The Sword of Kuromori by Jason Rohan
