**Jamie Reign: the last spirit warrior** by P.J. Tierney

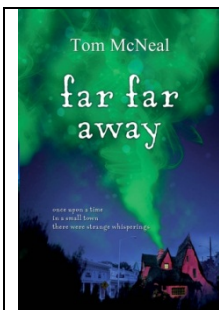

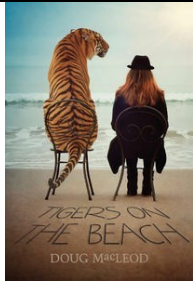
***Saving Thanehaven*** by Catherine Jinks
